### HOW TO ACCUMULATE POINTS

- ASSIGNMENTS, Engagement, PROJECTS, ETC. (50%) I will post zoom meetings, lesson videos and assignments in google classroom. Lessons will be completed and checked during our mandatory zoom meetings. Practice assignments should be completed, corrected and turned in daily through the turn in feature on GC or by email, but will be considered "on time" and graded up to the following Monday (until 9pm). Late assignments will be accepted until the following Monday (until 9pm) for up to 50% credit. After which time, the assignment is too late to get any credit. It is the student's responsibility to check the accuracy of their work. I will go over and post most if not all answers, so you will get credit on your assignments by showing your work.
- ASSESSMENTS (50%): Tests will cover about 2-3 weeks' worth of material. Tests will be given through Khan Academy and also by other means. Tests through Khan Academy will have a window of time (generally a few days) in which they need to be completed. After which time, no credit will be given.
- CLASS PARTICIPATION (NOW INCLUDED WITHIN ASSIGNMENT CATEGORY): It is expected that you participate in class and you are engaged in the lessons and activities on a daily basis.

# ATTENDANCE

Attending class every day and being on time is critical. Students missing class miss out on notes, homework
assignments and explanation of new material. Attendance will be taken daily and reported to the attendance
office. Missed assignments will be accepted for full credit only if the absence is excused. Punctuality will also be
monitored. Tardiness will be handled according to school policy. <u>It is expected that you attend all zoom
meetings, be on time and stay in the meeting until you are excused.</u>

- There will be a chat button in the bottom right of your screen, this is a place where we can type back and forth. Please do not make or post comments unrelated to our class. All members in the Zoom will see this chat.
- This is a new learning method for all of us. Please be forgiving of mistakes. If there is a connection issue, please remain on zoom for at least 5 minutes and check back in 10 minutes. IF PROBLEMS CONTINUE, I WILL GIVE UPDATED DIRECTIONS THROUGH GOOGLE CLASSROOM OR EMAIL.
- If a student exhibits inappropriate behavior either visually or verbally, they may be removed from the meeting and referred to the administration for punishment.
- Make sure when you leave the chat, that you click Leave Meeting to turn off your device's video camera for your privacy.
