

ATHLETICS

As we consider the possibility that athletics will restart before the end of the 2020-21 school year, important eligibility information follows. Completing the following two requirements in advance will ease the return-to-play transition. Remember, though, no announcement has been made regarding athletics, and there is currently no reopening timeline.

1. Ensure that you have an updated physical. You can access the form at jfk.scusd.edu/athletic-clearance.
2. Complete the required athletic clearance process online at athleticclearance.com.

LCFF EXTENSION

Good news! The California Department of Education's (CDE) recently directed districts to stop collecting meal applications after a decision by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) that [all children would be allowed to receive meals at no cost until June 2021](#).

EQ AMBASSADORS


