HOW TO ACCUMULATE POINTS:

• **HOMEWORK-QUIZZES (25%):** Assignments will be completed using the assigned text and periodic handouts. Practice assignments should be completed daily unless instructed otherwise. It is the student's responsibility to check the accuracy of their work. Late assignments will NOT be accepted without excused absences.

• **NOTEBOOK (5%):** DAILY NOTEBOOKS are part of your success will depend on taking notes. The notebooks will be kept as a journal and collected at the end of each quarter. It is the student's responsibility to acquire any missed notes.

• **Progress Assessments (25%):** Test will be taken weekly and will consist of multiple choice and free response questions. Tests are focused directly on the problems completed from homework and topics discussed in class. Students are allowed to retake progress assessments as needed to improve grades.

• Unit Assessments (25%): Tests will be taken at midway or at the end of each unit. Students will be asked to answer ONLY free response questions. Students are NOT allowed to retake the unit assessments. Practice assessments will be given prior to each unit assessments.

• **FINAL (20%):** A cumulative final will be given at the end of each semester and will make up 20% of your total grade. The Math 1 End-of-Course Exam will be given at the end of the school year.

Attendance:

Attending class every day and being on time are critical. Students missing class will miss out on notes, homework assignments and explanation of new material. Attendance will be taken daily and reported to the attendance office. Late work will only be accepted if the absence is excused. Punctuality will also be monitored. Tardiness will be handled according to school policy.

• Student progress will be closely monitored. In addition to the school's reporting process and Infinite Campus online, I will post student grades every week.
